(Only one high point division per Horse & Rider Combination)

Divisions:

- Beginner Rider: Rider 12 or under, must never have cantered in judged show
- Novice Rider: Rider, 13 & older, must never have cantered in judged show
- Green Horse: Rider any age, may cross enter open lope classes.
- Junior Rider: Rider is 17 or under.
- Senior Rider: Rider is 18 or older.

High Point Classes:

- Beginner Rider: (W / T) 8 18 20 41
- Novice Rider: (W / T) 9 26 31 42
- Green Horse: (W / T) 10 27 32 43
- Junior Rider: (W/T/C) 11 28 33 44
- Senior Rider: (W/T/C) 12 29 34 45

Equestrians under 18 must wear an ASTM approved helmet, securely fastened, while mounted or otherwise handling a horse, on any part of Silver Sands property.

- Ribbons: First through sixth places.
- Negative Coggins is required - there are no exceptions.
- Judging based on AQHA, USA Equestrian & SSBC rules. Judges decisions are final.
- All ties are broken by the Horsemanship Class.
- All stallions must be handled by an adult (18 or older).
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs allowed on SSBC grounds.
- All riders must sign a SSBC "Waiver & Indemnity" Release form.
- SSBC is not responsible for loss or injury to a horse, rider or property.
- Required - appropriate dress, boots, tack and, if under 18, ASTM helmets must be worn.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times.**
- Classes may be divided if entries warrant.
- To qualify for end of day High Point, same horse and rider team is required to go in Showmanship, Pleasure and Horsemanship in their chosen division.**
- Refunds will be issued if dropping a class two classes prior to the dropped class.

- Non-Blue Horse and Rider combos must never have placed first, riding in any judged show.
- The Novice and Green Horse Divisions are limited to two show years.
- The Green Horse may enter open Lope classes and open schooling but no other division classes..
- A Green Horse may not enter any division classes other than it's own Green division classes.
- Novice Rider is a person new to judged showing with less than two show years experience.
- Horse/Rider team may not cross over high point divisions in any classes.**
- ***Jackpot Pleasure Classes - Choose only one, Amateur or Open. An amateur is one who does not receive payment for training, lessons, etc.**
