

2010 SHOW INFORMATION

STALLIONS – Not allowed in ANY Beginner rider/ handler classes. Handlers must be 19 yrs of age or over.

EXHIBITOR'S AGE DETERMINATION is the 1st of January of the current year.

STOCK/HUNTER TYPE HORSES should display the conformation associated with Thoroughbred, European Warmblood, Appaloosa, Paint or Quarter Horse breeding.

PLEASURE/SADDLE TYPE HORSES should display the conformation associated with Arabian, Morgan, American Saddlebred, Tennessee Walker or Missouri Foxtrotter breeding.

DRUGS - All horses are subject to random drug testing at the owners' expense by the decision of Show Committee and/or Judge.

SAFETY CONCERNS -horses must be under control at all times. At the discretion of the Judge and/or the Show Committee, Exhibitors may be excused from the arena. The horse will be excused from the Arena for the remainder of the day, trailered out or stalled. All horses must be ridden in a bridle or a bosal at all times, while on the show grounds.

ALL PERSONS PRESENT ON THE SHOW GROUNDS SHALL BE ORDERLY, RESPONSIBLE, SPORTSMANLIKE AND HUMANE IN THE TREATMENT OF ANIMALS. SHOW MANAGEMENT MAY IMMEDIATELY EXPEL OFFENDERS FROM THE SHOW GROUNDS

All dogs must be on a leash in hand or tied on a line no longer that 6' and kept under control at all times. Dogs are not allowed by the arena fence. Vehicles

NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES, BIKES OR SCOOTERS ALLOWED AROUND ARENA AREA.

ALL MOTORIZED VEHICLES ARE TO BE DRIVEN BY LICENSED DRIVERS ONLY.

PLEASE PARK IN THE DESIGNATED AREAS

HUNTER/SPORT HORSE, LUNGE LINE & SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES will be run as an In & Out Class.

LEAD LINE RIDERS are eligible for Classes 7 & 15 only (8 & under)

WALK ONLY RIDERS are eligible for Classes 7 & 17 and all In-Hand classes only (10 & under)

STEP-UP CLASSES are for those riders, 14 and over that are in the walk/trot classes and want to try and lope. Eligible for one year only, **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Beginner Horses are not eligible.

BEGINNER RIDERS are eligible for Classes 19, 21, 29, 31, 58, 59 and the all In-Hand classes only.

BEGINNER RIDERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE BEGINNER HORSE CLASSES.

BEGINNER RIDER– If rider has cantered and placed at any show, **NOT ELIGIBLE, (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE STEP-UP CLASSES)** for the beginner rider classes.

BEGINNER RIDERS ages 12 and older eligible for these classes for 2 years.

35 & OVER WALK/TROT RIDERS– If the rider has cantered and placed at any show during the current year, **-NOT ELIGIBLE, (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE STEP-UP CLASSES)**

BEGINNER HORSES are eligible for Classes 20, 22, 27, 30, 58, 59 and all the In-Hand classes.

BEGINNER HORSES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE BEGINNER RIDER OR STEP-UP CLASSES.

BEGINNER HORSE – If horse has cantered and placed at any show, **NOT ELIGIBLE** for the beginner horse classes. Horse is eligible for these classes for 2 years.

THREE & UNDER LONGE LINE HORSES are not eligible for any riding classes or to be ridden on the grounds
IN HAND TRAIL – 3 and under **NON-RIDING HORSES** are eligible for this class.

WATERING & DRAGGING OF THE ARENA WILL BE AFTER THE LUNCH BREAK**More information on backside**

All persons being present on show grounds shall be orderly, responsible, sportsmanlike and humane in the treatment of animals. Show management may immediately expel offenders from show grounds.
