#### **ATTN TRAIL EXHIBITORS:**

Riders must check in at the trail arena gate between 7:30-9:30 and sign in for their order of go. Each rider that signs in is booked for a 4 min time slot to complete their go in the order they check in. Any riders who have not signed in by 10:00 at the trail gate will not be put into the order of go and will forfeit their class. If you are not on course by your start time you forfeit your class. Trail will not be run past 12:00 the last rider must be on course by 11:55. (4 hours of trail time = 60 riders at 4 minutes ea.) Trail awards will be presented in the indoor arena before class 45.

#### **ATTN OVER FENCES EXHIBITORS:**

You must sign up at the registration desk for your classes no later than 11:30. An order of go will be posted around 12:30 for the over fences classes. There will be no changes to the order of go once it is made. If you miss your time you forfeit the class. Courses will be posted at 12:00. Warm up in the jumping arena will be allowed for 30 minutes after the course is set.

#### **ATTN RANCH HORSE EXHIBITORS:**

Ranch Horse is designed to show off the versatility of the well trained, well mannered working stock type horse in three classes pleasure, trail & horsemanship. Ranch horse pleasure classes are shown on the rail where horses may be asked to extend the trot and lope and a headset where the poll is carried above the wither is considered desirable. Ranch horse trail class where riders may be asked to dally from the horn and drag a log. Carry a slicker, bucket or tarp, ground tie, open the gate to enter the arena and mount/dismount. Ranch horse horsemanship patterns may ask for spins, lead changes and galloping. Horses in this division may not show with silver on their saddles or headstalls, they must show in western working tack. A minimal amount of conservatively sized silver conchos where it is a necessity for the construction of the saddle or bridle is acceptable. Riders attire should also be conservative.

#### **ATTN ALL EXHIBITORS:**

In an effort to keep the show on time we are strictly enforcing a 1 minute gate call. All classes will pre load when the prior class lines up. The gate will not be held for any reason if your late you forfeit your class – no refunds.

Classes will move quickly you should stay close to the arena & pay attention. No holding the gate for tack changes will be allowed. If you need a tack change you may excuse yourself from line up to give yourself extra time for a tack change. The indoor arena will be open for warm up riders from 7:00-7:30 and again for a short time at lunch. Lunging is allowed ONLY in the Rodeo arena which will be open most of the day for warm ups.

\*\*All start times listed are approximate please be ready for your class in advance if classes get canceled or have low entries things will move more quickly. Unforeseen issues may arise that could cause classes to start later as well. Also if trail has over 60 riders it may bump reining into the indoor arena after the Ranch horse classes. If trail runs short it will bump Ranch horse into the Rodeo arena after reining. This means the Western classes may start earlier or later depending on trail. Announcements will be made for changes.

\*CSHA Amateur riders may enter the open classes to earn points toward the year end hi point amateur divisions.

### **Driving Directions:**

Attendants will tell you where to park - Please only park horse trailers in designated area for Horse Show parking. Cars must park separately in the West lot. Any cars in the trailer parking will be towed.
