SPHO Rules apply to all classes; which state that show clothes are not required: Long pants & appropriate footwear with a heel required; neat, clean clothes appropriate to the discipline (jeans or breeches & a clean shirt), ASTM or approved helmet **is** optional and strongly encouraged. For driving classes, any type of harness or vehicle is allowed as long as it is in good condition and safe.

Youth – 18 yrs. old & Under Adult – 19-49 yrs. old Elite – 50 yrs. old & Over Open – all ages.

*Riders in leadline classes can only show in leadline & assisted classes.

Assisted Classes: Rider/handler 10 years and younger. Can only show in leadline and/or assisted classes. Adult Handler must be in ring to take control of horse if needed. Leadline must be attached to horse's bridle. In Down & Back Handler can not RUN – **JOG only – helmets REQUIRED in contest classes for Assisted Youth.

***Novice Rider/Handler: The rider/handler's first or second year of showing

^Trail classes excluded from cross-over, as they are only offered in 2-gait

2-gait: The trot & intermediate gait are interchangeable. Intermediate gait is any gait the horse naturally performs between the walk and the canter, i.e. trot, jog, pace, running walk, rack, etc., and all are given equal consideration. Entries in the 2-gait classes may NOT show in the 3-gait classes with the exception of Standardbred 3-gait classes & trail classes.

3-gait: To be judged at the walk, intermediate gait, and canter. Please see "2-gait" for definition of intermediate gait. Entries in 3-gait classes may NOT show in the 2-gait classes with the exception of Standardbred 3-gait classes and trail classes.
